

## New Gardening Class for 2010 - Very Hands-On - Feb. 2 to March 23

First, expand your gardening toolbox by covering the basics with four weeks of solid, no nonsense garden information and activities, then go on to design a real garden, developing new skills and hands-on experience. In this series of classes, participants will move easily through the basics and then develop actual sustainable, lower maintenance landscape designs for their homes. Drafting skills are NOT required!

These classes will put you into the shoes of the garden designer, listening to the client, measuring the space, envisioning an appropriate design concept, supporting your design concept, and figuring out which plants where. Work alone or with another team member.

Classes will be held from 10 AM to 2 PM on Tuesdays, from February 2 to March 23 at a private home in the historic community of Paeonian Springs, Virginia. The first class on basics runs from February 2 to February 23. Fee is \$96. Registration is required and the fee for all 8 classes is \$180. Class size is limited.
